Caution

- Avoid using the product in humid, dusty, extremely hot or cold environments, see the product data sheet for specific temperature and humidity requirements.
- Do not touch the sensor or lens part directly to avoid staining and damage by oil and various chemicals, if necessary, please moisten a clean cloth slightly and gently wipe off the dust. When the product is not in use, close the lens cap.
- When the product is turned on, a warm-up process of approximately 5-10 minutes may be required before accurate temperature data can be read.
- Avoid focusing or prolonged observation on the sun or objects with extremely high temperatures, as this may result in reduced sensor life damage or temporary black spots (minor cases can be recovered after calibrating the NUC, severe cases can result in permanent and irreversible damage to the detector).


- Avoid damage to the infrared sensor caused by over-range exposure.
- Take extra caution to keep the acoustic array from strains, dust, and liquids that could compromise the performance of the product or even cause permanent damage.
- It is strongly recommended to use the original power adapter, the specific requirements of the power adapter are shown in the product parameter table.
- To prevent the potential danger of data loss, always copy (back up) your data to your computer.
- When storing the product, it is strongly recommended to use the original box and place it in a cool, dry, ventilated environment free from strong electromagnetic fields.
- When shipping the product, it is highly recommended that it be shipped protected in its factory packaging.









Interface Introduction


Main interface



- 1) Display battery, Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, GPS, SD card capacity low, laser warning, Compass, time, Logo and other reminder icons.
- 2 Displays values for global and regional temperature, emissivity, area, and length, as well as units.
- ③ Displays values such as palette color band and upper and lower temperature scale limits.
- 4 Displays the real-time thermal/acoustic image screen, tem-

perature measurement markers, target distance and other values.

- ⑤ Enter the system menu.
- 6 Displays emissivity, reflected temperature, ambient temperature, relative humidity, target distance and other measurements.
- ① Switch among IR, AC and MiX mode.




- ① Select among automatic temperature span, manual temperature span, touch temperature span setting.
- ② Adjust emissivity, reflection temperature, ambient temperature, relative humidity, target distance, infrared window compensation factors.
- 3 Switch between infrared, visible light, picture-in-picture, and image blend mode.
- 4 Apply ROIs such as spot, rectangle, circle, line. Calculate temperature rise among ROIs or against a specific temperature value.

- (5) Apply various color palettes and inverse palettes, including color alarms (isotherms).
- 6 Change settings about capture mode, network connection, temperature measurement range, storage and save options, device settings, etc.




- ① Acoustic Parameters: Include Signal Source Mode (Single, Multi, and Hologram mode) and T-FFTD® signal delay option ગીr :
- 2 Acoustic Image Focus: Turns the acoustic focus on or off;
- ③ Measurement Tools: Add spot ♦ , circle and apply distance **p**arameter;
- 4 Palette Selection;
- 5 Detection Mode: PD Mode (partial discharge), LQ Mode ⇒ , and LQ Eval mode(leak evaluation) 🔻 settings;
- 6 Settings: Access Capture Mode, Connection, Storage & Save Options, Device Set, Plug-in Manager, etc.

Gallery



- ① Preview: Display the captured photos and videos. Short click to select, long press to multi-select;
- 2 Display only images with the favorite toggle activated;
- ③ Filtering by tags attached to the images;
- 4 Enter the analysis mode to analyze the captured pictures and video files.
- (5) Delete the selected file.

System settings



- 1) Capture mode: Switch between single-frame capture, recording, and time-lapse mode;
- 2 Connection: WLAN, Portable Hotspot, Bluetooth and FTP transfer;
- 3 Temperature range: Switch among 3 different temperature ranges, can also enable intelligent range;
- 4 Storage and save option: Super resolution, video compression format, saving visible light image as separate JPEG photos, saving measurement settings such as distance, and deletion of

all saved files;

- ⑤ Device set: Language time and region setting, USB mode, display setting, geographic location, LED as flash, volume, reset, device information, etc.;
- 6 IR device set: Focus type, TWB, IREdge, image overlay information, T-DEF transparency, and manual adjustment mode;
- 7 AC device set: Leak evaluation parameters, acoustic image focus range, frequency configuration, display dB value, AC frequency, SPL normalization, measurement enhancement and other settings;
- 8 Plug-in manager: Plug-ins for business and services, etc.

Quick Start

Please follow the steps below:

- Make sure the battery is fully charged.
- Place the battery in the camera's battery compartment.
- Insert the SD card into the corresponding slot.
- Long press the power button to turn on the device.
- Select IR. AC or MiX mode.
- Aim the camera at the target object.
- 7. Press the snapshot button once to freeze the image, and the user may conduct analysis and adjustment on the image.
- Press the snapshot button again to save the image.
- Download FOTRIC AnalyzIR Venus professional analysis software at https://www.fotric.com/fotric-analyzir
- 10. Install AnalyzIR Venus on your PC.
- 11. Launch AnalyzIR Venus.
- 12. Use a Type-C USB cable to connect the device to the PC or import data from the SD card to he PC with a SD card reader.
- 13. Copy images from the Gallery folder in the SD card to the PC.

- 14. Open AnalyzIR Venus import files into the software.
- 15. Analyze, save and generate reports.
- 16. Click Export to export the report as a Word file.



Caution

When using the IR mode, it is important to adjust the focus correctly. Incorrect focus adjustment may affect image clarity and measurement accuracy of this product.

Maintenance Instructions

- Temperature measuring equipment is recommended for temperature calibration measurement once every one to two years.
- Pay attention to keep the lens clean, use a soft non-woven cloth to gently wipe and brush away dust, or use an oilfree cotton cloth dipped in 96% concentration of ethanol, wring it out and wipe it gently, avoid wiping it hard to cause permanent damage to the lens.
- Please ensure that the battery is fully charged when storing for a long time.


